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DRAMA I

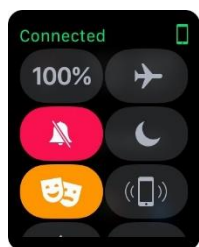
(1 Term Class – Fall and Spring)

An overview of the theatre arts, with an introduction to pantomime, creating character, and performing. The semester ends with a class production.

ADVANCED DRAMA

(Combined Drama 2 and 3 and Workshop)
(Full year class, alternating days)

Students in this class refine their acting skills, performing scenes & monologues from contemporary and classic theater, as well as original work. Drama Workshop seniors have the opportunity to direct a one-act play of their choosing.



THEATRE TECH

(1 Term Class, Fall and Spring)

An introduction to the behind-the-scenes work necessary to produce a play. Students receive instruction in basic design, lighting and sound, set building, costumes and make-up. They become the creative backbone of the Fall play and Spring musical.

REHERSAL AND PERFORMANCE

(1 Term Class, Fall and Spring)

Our newest theatre class, students who are case in our main stage shows are enrolled in this after school class. They receive a grade and credit for the extra hours they commit to rehearsing and performing.
